 - The Contractor is to make whatever inquiries of the respective Statutory Authorities he considers necessary to satisfy himself and to avoid disturbing any Statutory services.
 - All areas affected by the works shall be maintained and made good to replace or improve the existing surface as required by the Engineer on site.
